MORS Personal Security Voucher Instructions

Instructions

1. From the standpoint of security, MORS workshops are conducted by the Military Operations Research Society pursuant to the provisions of the DoD National Industrial Security Program Operating Manual (NISPOM) and are supervised by the OCNO, N81. The scope of the forthcoming workshop was published in an unclassified Announcement distributed separately.
2. Only US citizens who are employees and direct consultants of the US Government shall use this voucher. It shall be addressed to the OCNO, N81, an agency of the US Government.
3. All of the following conditions must be satisfied for all prospective attendees:
 - a. *The attendee MUST be a U.S. Citizen.*
 - b. *The attendee must have a current security clearance of at least SECRET.*
 - c. *The attendee must have a certified need-to-know justifying access to SECRET information.*
4. MORS requires a photographic identification card, which can be recognized at a distance of 3 feet to be the person by whom it is worn. The electronic photo should be a passport-type photo. The image of the head should be at least one inch high and be current and distinct. The photograph may be black and white or color. Background should be plain.
5. **DoD CAC cards may be used as your photo ID at this workshop. Please check the appropriate box at the top of this form.** If you do not have a DoD CAC card then a MORS Photo ID card is required, applicant should email an electronic photograph to the MORS Office at IDPhoto@mors.org with your name and last two digits of your SSN.
6. Hand carrying of classified documents to and from the forthcoming symposium, special meeting or workshop via commercial passenger aircraft is normally prohibited. Exemptions require specific authorization as indicated in Chapter 8, DoD Directive 5200.1R.
7. All of the blanks must be filled in with a felt tip pen or typed. The Military Operations Research Society is not prepared to research missing or ambiguous information.
