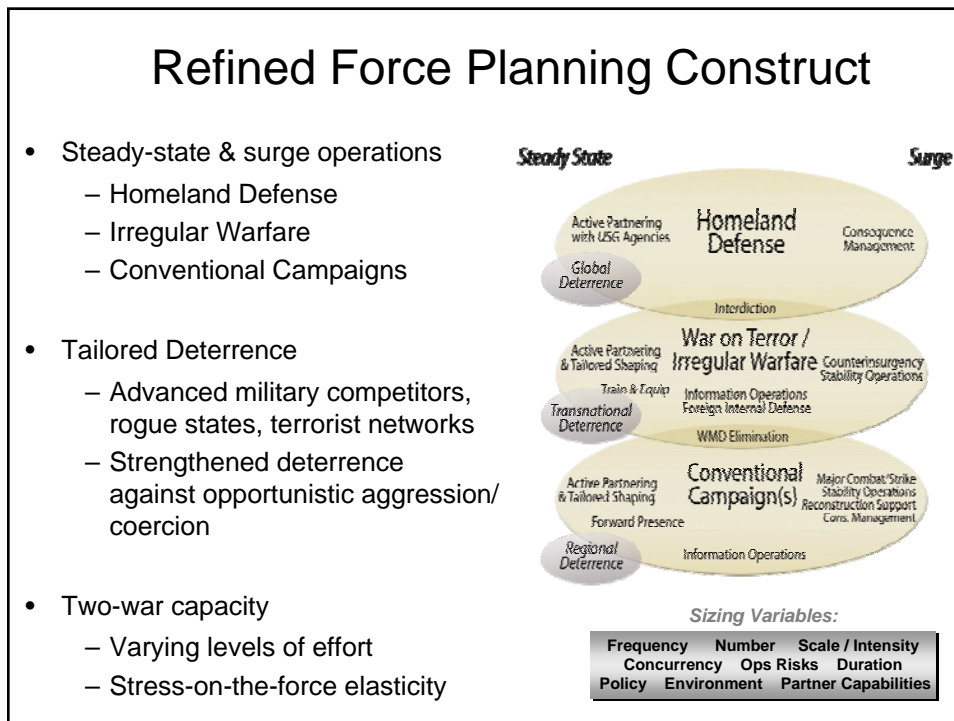
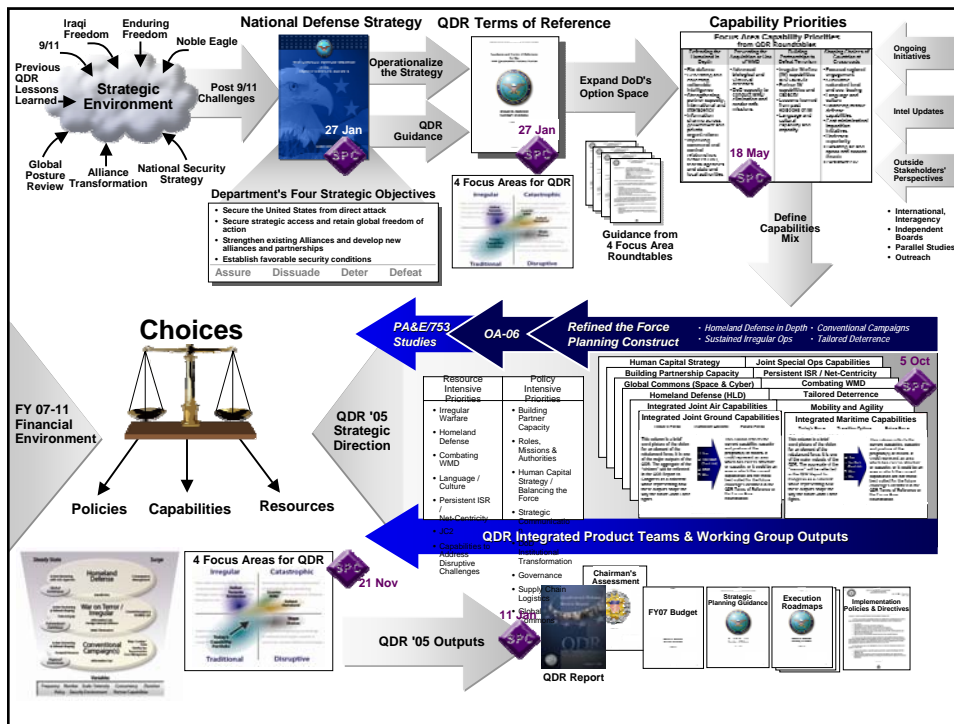
## QDR Objective – Shift in Focus



# Strategic Framework

- 4 Core Problems not well addressed by traditional modeling & simulation capability
- Open, collaborative, transparent analysis
- Integrated, augmenting, & complementary analysis
- Employ a broad array of analytic methods and tools
- Analysis establishes decision trade space and options for leadership not solutions
- Capability mix for 4 core problems drive adjustments to databases and tools
- Analysis continues to transform to remain responsive to QDR timelines and requirements
- Maximize parallel & minimize sequential analytic preparation
- 19 discrete analytic nodes identified to date





# An Analytic Construct


Tier One:

- Lethality –  $P_k$
- Deployability – C-Day
- Transportability - UTC

Tier Two:

- Capability - JCA
- Availability - Rotation
- Simultaneity – Sand Chart

Tier Three:

- Capacity
- Equivalency
- Creativity
